

Plat of Medford



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The above plat being a part of the S. $1/4$, Section 6, Town 19, North Range 11 East; described as follows:

Commencing 20 ft West of the S. E. corner of said S. $1/4$, running thence North on a line at right angles to South line of said section 335 ft, thence West parallel to said South line 708 ft, thence Southeasterly along East line of the C. R. & M. R. R. right of way $378\frac{3}{4}$ ft. to South line of said Section, thence East 52 1/2 ft. to place of beginning. estimated to contain 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.

The dimensions of the lots and widths of streets and alleys are marked on their respective margins.
